
Lid open

Mounting to desk



Ensure arips on both sides of the module are rotated flush against the sides first.



Lower the Horizon module into the cut-out hole in the desk.1*



Rotate the grips back out on either side of the module.




Tighten the bolts inside the module to clamp the grips to the desk.

Lid operation



Lift up the lid from the front lip adjacent to the brush strip. Pivot back until vertical.








Raising/lowering the module



Use both hands to lift up the module at both ends. Lift until a click is heard.




To lower, depress the side buttons as shown and gently lower the module to the bottom.

Connecting standard 3-pole connector




Plug the male 3-pole connector supplied as standard into a female powered connector.




Ensure the attached locking mechanism clicks into place on both connectors.

Disconnecting standard 3-pole connector




Use a suitable tool to release the locking mechanism.




Separate the connectors.

Connecting data/AV (if applicable)




Offer up the data/AV cable connectors to the related ports on the module.




Connect cables from the module to the source. Use suitable cable management for safety.

USB charging (if applicable)



Insert the USB connector from your device into the related port on the module.



Ensure the cable is securely connected.
